

**Consular Warden Message – July 25, 2007**  
**U.S. Embassy Dakar**

The U.S. Embassy in Dakar is issuing this Warden Message to inform U.S. citizens of the potential for significant traffic disruptions in Dakar on July 26.

French President Nicolas Sarkozy will arrive in Dakar, Senegal in the early afternoon on Thursday, July 26, 2007 and depart the following morning. His motorcade movements will likely disrupt normal traffic flow and the police may control portions of the Autoroute, VDN, and the Corniche West. Anticipate traffic delays and re-routing on the Corniche and Rue d'Ouakam throughout the day on July 26.

**Other Information:**

Americans living or traveling in Senegal or Guinea-Bissau are encouraged to register with the U.S. Embassy in Dakar through the State Department's travel registration website, <https://travelregistration.state.gov>, and to obtain updated information on travel and security within Senegal.
