

**Consular Warden Message**  
**February 21, 2007**

The U.S. Embassy in Dakar is issuing this Warden Message to inform American citizens that the U.S. Embassy has just confirmed reports of election related violence the evening of Wednesday, February 21 throughout Dakar, including in areas and a restaurant frequented by expatriates. The U.S. Embassy recommends that American citizens avoid going out in public during the evening hours. The U.S. Embassy will send more details on Thursday, February 22, 2007.

Americans living or traveling in Senegal are encouraged to register with the nearest U.S. Embassy or Consulate through the State Department's travel registration website, <https://travelregistration.state.gov>, and to obtain updated information on travel and security within Senegal.

Americans without Internet access may register directly with the nearest U.S. Embassy or Consulate. By registering, American citizens make it easier for the Embassy or Consulate to contact them in case of emergency.
