Change in Hours of Operation for American Citizen Services

This Warden Message alerts U.S. citizens to a change in hours of operation for routine American Citizen Services at the U.S. Embassy in Dakar, Senegal.

Beginning the week of February 22, 2010, the Embassy will be open for routine American Citizen Services during the following times:

Mondays 9:00 – 12:00 pm
Tuesdays 9:00 – 12:00 pm
Thursdays 9:00 – 12:00 pm

No appointment is necessary to be served during these hours; service is provided on a walk-in, first-come, first-served basis.

The Consular Section will receive U.S. citizens in emergency situations at any time during working hours, from Monday to Thursday from 8:00 to 5:00. For after-hour emergencies, please call: 33-829-2109.

U.S. citizens residing or traveling in Senegal and Guinea Bissau are encouraged to register with the Embassy through the State Department's travel registration website, <https://travelregistration.state.gov/ibrs/ui/>, to obtain updated travel and security information. U.S. citizens without Internet access may register directly with the Embassy. Registration is important because it allows the Embassy and the State Department to assist you with an emergency.
