How to Register With the U.S. Embassy in Dakar

If you are an American citizen living or traveling in Senegal or Guinea-Bissau, the U.S. State Department and the Embassy in Dakar strongly encourage you to register your trip on the State Department's travel registration website at <https://travelregistration.state.gov>. Americans without Internet access may register in person at the nearest U.S. Embassy or Consulate.

Registering your trip allows Embassies abroad to send you newsletters and time-sensitive travel warnings and public announcements specific to the areas in which you will be traveling or living. The information you provide also makes it easier for Embassies to contact you in case of emergency, or to contact your family or friends in the United States in the event of an emergency abroad.

If you have not already registered online, please create an account at <https://travelregistration.state.gov>. When you register, make sure you register as a **long-term** traveler even though you plan to stay in Senegal less than six months. This will ensure that your information is transferred to our local database and we can contact you via e-mail. If you have already registered online, please ensure that your registration and travel plans are current.

You may update your contact information on the Internet at any time. The data you provide is secured behind Department of State firewalls, accessible only by cleared personnel in Embassies, Consulates, and the Department of State, and releasable only under the provisions of the Privacy Act.

Important: If you do not receive a welcome message from our mailing service within a week of registration, please email us directly at consulardakar@state.gov so we can manually add your address.
